

## Park Services Operatives Needed! (Weekends & School/Bank Holidays)

To join our Park Services Team, you'll need to be confident in welcoming and dealing with diverse groups of people. Friendly, courteous and helpful behaviour should come naturally to you and you'll be expected to work well both as part of a team and independently. Good communication skills (attentive listening & strong verbal communication) are essential, as is the willingness to work flexible hours (especially on weekends and during school holidays).

## Duties include:

- Maintaining the cleanliness of the site, including litter collection, emptying bins and sweeping of pathways and other areas
- Regular car park duties (assisting and directing visitors in a safe and polite manner) and manning the zebra crossing
- Helping set up for functions and events (tables, chairs and other equipment)
- Drive the Rex Express Train ride, sell tickets to our visitors and ensure they have a safe and enjoyable ride
- Undertaking basic maintenance duties, including sanding, painting, helping erect fencing and other odd jobs

## **Requirements:**

• Experience preferred, although not essential as full job-specific training will be given

- Positions are seasonal, so you will be expected to work during the school holidays
- It is essential that you can work at least 1 day of each weekend
- Various shifts available, generally 8-hours shifts worked between 08.00-18.30, which include weekday and weekend/Bank Holiday work
- Potential for positions to become permanent for the right candidate

In return, you'll receive at least National Minimum Wage, full uniform, a range of staff discounts/benefits and the opportunity to be part of Hertfordshire's number one visitor attraction.
